



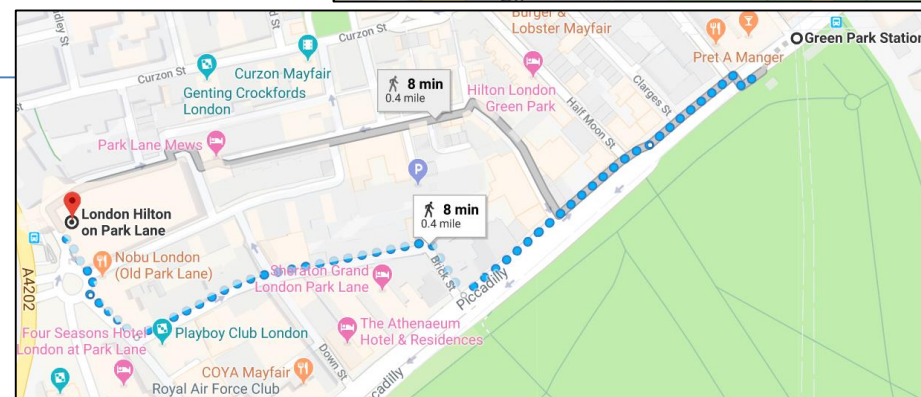
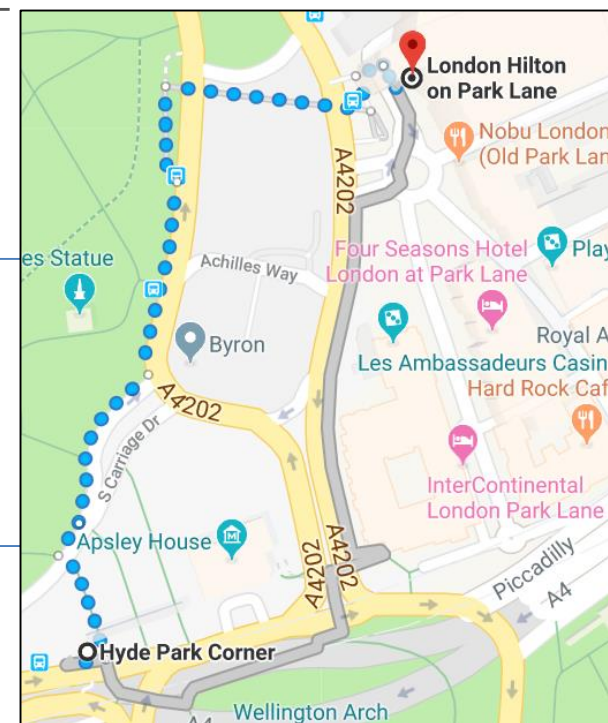
## London Hilton on Park Lane 5\*

From London Heathrow Airport (17.5 miles) – Catch the **Heathrow Express** to London Paddington station. This train leaves Heathrow every 15 minutes and is an average 15 minute journey to Paddington. From Paddington, catch a **Circle** Line train towards Victoria, alighting at Gloucester Road. Then catch a **Piccadilly** Line train towards Cockfosters, alighting at Hyde Park Corner. It is then 0.3 mile walk to the hotel.

From London Stansted Airport (41.5 miles) – Catch the **Stansted Express** to London Liverpool Street station. Trains leave every 15 minutes and take 45 minutes. From Liverpool Street, catch a **Central** Line train towards West Ruislip and alight at Holborn. Then catch a **Piccadilly** Line train towards Heathrow Terminal 5, alighting at Hyde Park Corner

From London City Airport (10 miles) – Catch a **DLR** train from Platform 2 towards Bank and alight at Canning Town. Then catch a **Jubilee** line train towards Willesden Green and alight at Green Park. It is then a 0.4 mile walk to the hotel.

From London Gatwick Airport (30 miles) – Catch the **Gatwick Express** to London Victoria station. Trains leave every 15 minutes and take 30 minutes. From London Victoria, catch a **Victoria** Line train towards Walthamstow Central, and alight at Green Park.





## Get to the Southbank Centre

Exit the main hotel doors and turn left. Follow the road across the roundabout and slight left along Old Park Lane. Turn left up Brick Street and at the end, cross the pedestrian crossing and turn left.

After 300ft, turn right across the park on Half Moon Street. After 0.2 miles slight left.

When you reach the small black metal gate, continue through and this will bring you out onto Cleveland Row. Continue straight onto Pall Mall.

Turn right at the King George III Statue onto Cockspur Street. Go straight over the roundabout with Equestrian Stature of Charles I onto Northumberland Avenue.

At the end of Northumberland Avenue, cross the river on the Golden Jubilee Bridges. The Royal Festival Hall is on the left hand side of the bridges.

Alternatively, from Green Park Station take a Jubilee Line train towards Stratford and alight at Waterloo. With the main entrance of Waterloo Station behind you, cross the road at the pedestrian crossing at the bottom of the street. Follow the pedestrian walkway under the blue bridge (Sutton Walk). Exit the walkway left and cross Belvedere Road. The Southbank Centre is up the steps straight in front of you.
